WHAT IS PATIENT CENTERED MEDICAL HOME?

“Patient Centered Medical Home” (PCMH) is how health care is delivered to patients. Caring about YOU is the most important job of your Care Center. In this personal model of health care, your primary physician/provider at STMP - Lenox Village works as the gate keeper to coordinate your care with hospitalists and specialists and leads the team of health care professionals that, collectively, takes responsibility for your care. The Medical Home model emphasizes improving and maintaining lifestyles through evidence-based care. It is a medical team working together to provide you with the best possible care. Your Care Team makes sure you get the care you need - in wellness as well as illness-to heal your body, mind and spirit. Patients are responsible for providing a complete medical history and information about care obtained outside the practice. We are here to work with you and provide the support you need.

WHO IS THE PCMH CARE TEAM?

Your team may include a physician, advanced nurse practitioner, certified physician assistant, nurse, medical assistant, as well as other health professionals, such as a pharmacist or nutritionist. They will help you get healthy, stay healthy, and get the care and services that are right for you. When needed, your provider arranges for appropriate care with other qualified provider specialists.

LEARNING ABOUT YOU.

- * Get to know you, your family, your life situation, and preferences. Remember these details about you every time you seek care, and suggest treatments that make sense for you
- * Treat you as a full partner in your care
- * Communicate with you
- * Give you time to ask questions, and answer them in a way you understand
- * Make sure you know and understand all of your options for care
- * Help decide what care is best for you
- * Sometimes more care is not better care

SUPPORTING YOU IN CARING FOR YOURSELF.

- * Make sure you develop a clear idea of how to care for yourself
- * Help you set goals for your care, and help meet your goals one step at a time
- * Give you information about classes, support groups, or other types of services to help you learn more about your condition and stay healthy
- * Encourage you to fully participate in recommended preventive screenings and services
